Graeme has just completed a new version of RED Color Science and we are looking for a few test pilots to try it out.

The improvements are meaningful and improve image color throughout the spectrum but specifically address shooting under tungsten light.

We will pick a handful of volunteers that have **no other commitment** for about a week. **You need to NOT be in the middle** of a shoot and have time to run tests without the pressure of switching builds back and forth during the testing period.

You will get a new firmware build for the camera and a new RED Alert! to open the files. After testing, you will be able to go back to your old build... or a newer build that includes this color science if it is as successful in testing as we think it will be. If and when we make the decision to change to the new color, we will change the SDK to incorporate the new color and inform all that use the SDK.
