- Sony NEX-FS700 Release: June 2012 Appx \$10k
 - **Sony E mount** (Adapter available for Sony Alpha mount) (also Metabones lens mount allows camera to electronically control iris on EOS lenses)
 - S35 sensor
 - '4K ready' Upgrade to 4K (4096 x 2160) output in under 12mths
 - 1480fps up to approx. 9sec

(1920x432 skipped readout, interpolated to 1920x1080 recording)

- **960fps** up to approx. 19sec (1920x216 skipped readout, interpolated to 1920x1080 recording)
- 120fps can shoot up to approx. 16 secs,
- **240fps** can shoot up to approx. 8 secs. (Both in full HD)
- **LCD panel** is the same as FS100, ie. 3.5" 921K 16:9 type.
- **3G-SDI output** (FS100 just has HDMI)
- 8.4MP Stills mode
- In camera ND filters as with F3 (Fs100 no ND's)
- Same AVCHD format recording to Memory stick or SD
- Also works with the FMU-128 dock-able flash memory unit






